GENERAL RULES

1) **Liability:** The Iowa Summer Spectacular, its management, the Iowa Equestrian Center or Kirkwood Community College and its employees will not be responsible for any loss, injury or damage done to or caused by any animal or article on exhibition. Each exhibitor will be responsible for any injury that be occasioned to any person, whomsoever, by any horse owned or exhibited by him and shall indemnify the Iowa Summer Spectacular, or any member thereof, against all claims and demands, of any nature or kind, that may grow out of any injury occasioned by any horse owned or exhibited by them, or arise from the negligence of the person in charge of any such horse. All horses exhibited in this show will be entirely at the owner's risk.

The show committee reserves the right to make such changes in procedures, officials, personnel, rules and regulations as shall be deemed by them to be in the best interest of the show.

2) **Protests:** A protest must be filed as set forth under IHSA Rules.

3) **Entry Information:** All entries – halter and performance, close July 5, 2009 and must be *received* on or before that date. No horse will be permitted to compete unless properly entered on the official entry blank. Complete information and all signatures must be filled out on the entry blank. Enclose completed entry blank, with check / money order made payable to the Iowa Summer Spectacular for all entry and stall fees.

ALL ENTRIES MUST BE SENT IN WITH A CHECK FOR ALL FEES. IF CHECK IS NOT ENCLOSED FOR ALL FEES, ENTRIES WILL BE RETURNED.

- 4) **Arrival & Departure:** Horses / ponies will be allowed in the barns starting at 8 am Thursday, July 23 and must be out by Sunday night.
- 5) **Bedding:** ALL BEDDING MUST BE ORDERED ON ENTRY FORM. YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BRING YOUR OWN BEDDING per facility policy.
- 6) **Refunds:** Full refund of ENTRY FEES ONLY will be given to any entry withdrawn if show secretary is notified by July 7, 2009. NO REFUNDS will be made without a veterinarian's certificate received in the show office after 1:00PM on July 24, 2009. Any 'vet outs' at the show, from July 24-26, must be written by the Show Veterinarian. ABSOLUTELY NO STALL REFUNDS. All refunds will be mailed less office charge per horse.
- 7) **Cancellations:** The show management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that have less than three entries, or split classes where necessary.
- 8) **Show tab:** All charge accounts at the show must be covered by a signed check received in the show office made out to IOWA SUMMER SPECTACULAR before any numbers will be issued.
- 9) **Camping** is available for \$15/night. If you wish to camp, please indicate on entry form and send money with entries. **Camping fees must be paid with entries.**
- 10) **Stake classes:** To be eligible for a stake class, all horses and ponies must have been shown and judged in qualifying class in their division.
- 11) **Admission to Arena:** No person will be permitted to enter the arena except participants in the class, officials and their assistants. Attendants will not be permitted in the arena until summoned by order of the judge.
- 12) **Dogs:** All dogs must be on a leash or tied in stalls.
- 13) **Show Office hours:** The Horse Show Office will be open July 23, 2009 from noon to 8 pm. For the remainder of the show, the office will close 1 hour before each session and be open for 30 minutes after each session.
- 14) **Health Requirements:** All out of state horses must have current coggins test dated within last 12 months and health papers dated within 30 days of show.
- 15) **HAY- If you need hay at the show, please call Nancy Weber (Stabling Manager) before July 21nd . ALL HAY MUST BE PRE-ORDERED.**
- 16) **Smoking - Smoking is forbidden anywhere on the Kirkwood grounds. This includes the parking lots and any of the Kirkwood facilities.**

STABLING: Due to the limited number of stalls in the horse stall barn (206 stalls), we will be putting the extra stalls in the annex. These stalls have cement floors and first bedding will NOT be provided. All horses exhibited must have assigned stalls.

NO STALLS will be held without payment.
